3. The INSTRUCTIONS FOR " Working Tiny Hands" competition are:

By June in each partner country should" Working Tiny Hands" competition to be held

- making toys of different materials - clay, refuse material, fabric and yarn.

Each partner should to choose and present three toys at least (one of each type of the materials), that will participate in the competition between the partners, which will be held in Norway in September 2014.

BY ALL MADE TOYS SHOULD BE PRESENTED/DISPLAYED THREE TOYS AT LEAST. IN TWO WEEKS BEFORE the competition each partner country should to send an "exhibition" (as pdf. fail, video or presentation) to the Norwegian team. This "exhibition" should to include/display the used materials for creating the toys, the process steps of the creation and the results of making three toys at least – ONE OF CLAY, ONE OF REFUSE MATERIALS, ONE OF FABRIC AND YARN.Due to the difficulties involved in transporting, carrying a toy is not mandatory.

Third work session

- Parent's weekend "A day as a child" each partner country had the opportunity to present how the parent's weekend is passed in their kindergarten.
- Presentation of the traditional toys by all partners demonstration (what
 material is used in making the toy and how to play with the traditional toy) all
 traditional toys were given to the coordinator of the project.
- 3. Handover of CLOT toy the partners from Croatia gave the CLOT toy and its diary to the coordinator of the project the Turkish team. By the next mobility in Norway, CLOT will visit the children in Yakacik Doga Kindergarten and writes down its experiences in the diary.



Fourth work session

The last work session was held in the atmosphere of the renovation of the renaissance school of XIX century in the complex "Old Dobrich".

- 1. Discussion the content of the progress report.
- 2. During the work mobility of the project, the Bulgarian team presented to the guests the Bulgarian folklore tradition in a concert " Sunny puzzle " with featuring children of " Sunshine" Kindergarten. The partners met with the little children from " Spring" Nursery. The cultural-historical program included a visit to the natural and archeological reserve Kaliakra cape, the University Botanical Garden in Belchik, the architectural complex in Balchik the Palace, and Albena resort the pearl on the North Coast. The visit ended with a traditional Bulgarian evening, during which all the guests were able to learn the steps of typical Bulgarian folk dances.
